SUJANA BAGS ₹ 148 CR ORDERS

Hyderabad: City-based Sujana Towers Limited has bagged three orders valued at ₹148.38 crore from SPIC SMO & SEW Infrastructure Limited for supply of transmission line towers.

These would be used in the transmission lines being constructed by it for Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd and Uttar Pradesh Vidyut Vitaran Nigam Ltd.

The company would design, test and supply about 16,700 mt of 400 kv multi circuit towers, over the next nine months. These trans-India lines would be erected and commissioned by SPIC and SEW, which would cater to 30 per cent of the Uttar Pradesh population, a release said.
